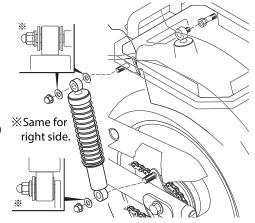

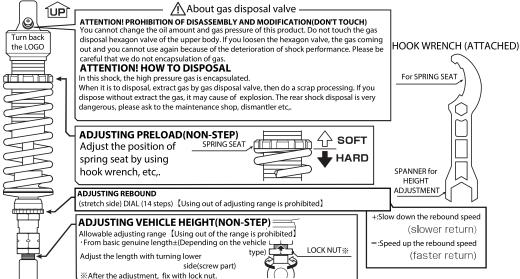

- Bolts and nuts may get loosen by engine vibration. Make sure not to loosen any bolts and nuts before driving.
- Do not modify the way which is not listed or it will cause damage and trouble.

HOW TO INSTALL

- %If there is a hard degradation like a blem, fatigue and wear etc on the reuse parts, please change to new ones.
- 1) Secure the motorcycle body, by placing the maintenance stand.
- 2)Remove the normal rear shock, then install the GEARS rear shock.
- **XTighten UPPER/LOWER mounting bolt(nut) with** designated torque.
- OUPPER:44N·m(4.5kgf·m)/LOWER 30N·m(2.9kgf·m) **When installing, please apply necessary amount of grease
- to the mounting bolts and bush of the vehicle side.
- 3)Adjust each part, making sure that the rear shock is stable before riding.





How to adjust the various points

- » Please park in a safe place to do adjustment.
- *Before adjustment, clean the dust, water, etc from adjustment place.
- Δ | stToo much re-tightening the adjustment dial may cause of hard wear and oil leak.

■ Preload adjustment(initial)

1)Loosen the set screw on the side of the preload adjust seat with hexagon wrench.

2) Apply silicone lubricant spray to protect the screw part of body. After the adjustment, please wipe it off.

3) Adjust by exclusive wrench to turn the preload adjusting seat. Turn to the right to make it hard, turn to the left to make it soft.

4)Finally, lightly tighten set screw(0.2~0.3kgf⋅m) to lock.

- *Be careful not to break screw part because of too much tightening.
- *The sag, the shrinkage amount while riding, compared to the one while it is jacked up. Around 1/3 of all stroke is roughly estimated.
- XYet, insure the 5mm of the sag when it is empty.

■ HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT

- · Please do adjustment that removed from vehicle.
- 1)Loosen the lock nut with turning to the left.
- 2) Turn the pillow ball part to the left to raise the height. Turn to the right to lower.
- XUsing out of the adjustable range is prohibited. (Please use the adjustable range below.)
- 3) After tightening the lock nut, install the rear shock to the vehicle.
- *The lock nut for height adjustment may get loosen by engine vibration, make sure to tight it regularly.
- ◆ Adjustment range (for DAX) -3~+4mm (Genuine basic length:0)



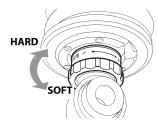
PRELOAD ADJUSTING SEAT

■ REBOUND ADJUSTMENT 14 STEPS

- · Make the speed of stretching(rebound) suspension slower when riding.
- · Adjust with dial.
- Turn to the (+)direction, for harder rebound (the speed of stretch side is slower).
- Turn to the (-)direction, for softer rebound (the speed of stretch side is faster).



CHECK POINTS AFTER THE INSTALLATION

- After the installation, some oils come out a little on the shaft, but it is not oil leaking. It is grease that applied at the time of manufactured. If there is too much, wipe it off with soft cloth.
- Make sure not to loosen the all the bolts, nuts regularly.
- If loosen, tighten the specified torque.

AFTER MAINTENANCE

Due to the structural principle of suspension, wear and oil deterioration progress in proportion to use. It is able to use longer with original performance for proper overhaul by specialist.

·Recommendation of overhaul pace(it is just a rough indication)

Once a year or every 5000km for street use

Once every season for racing use
